	Special Projects – Honors – L. Garrett	Item returned for further discussion and consideration of rationale provided by Liesel Reinhart. Reviewed submitted rationale. How do these courses meet the needs of transferring students? Do universities require units or courses? Current 99 courses don't transfer to UC, so if the 99H is approved, verify that course could be transferable for credit to UC.

		<p>The benefit of a 99H course would be to document research projects and participation and interaction with faculty doing research. You don't need the 99H course to achieve this. Unless the institution is going to accept it as one their transfer courses. There is no additional cost to having this course. What are the expectations of the course? Maybe the description of these 99H courses should be more robust as far as the level and quality of research and development of projects in the work presented. Counting or not counting towards the units for transfer should be communicated clearly to students. Will not get transfer status – concern Jamaika should research how the UC's are going to accept these courses. How would they fit in the Honors transfer program? Need rationale how a 99H course would fit in the Honors program. What are ramifications and impact on students? What about repeatability? If an Honors course is not UC transferable, should it be retrained as an Honors course? Should a course that has been denied transfer status by UC be revised?
