Grimes-Hillman	Recommended for Academic Senate approvalResolution brought forward reminds faculty to avoid copying and pasting C-ID descriptors into course outline of records.Psychology Department has a Statistics course (PSYC 10) without C-ID descriptor unlike SOC and MATH.Can PSYC 10 be submitted in another discipline?Can PSYC match the C-ID descriptor for SOC and MATH?Eric indicated that those courses would have to be identified as equivalent locally.Statistics descriptors are very specific for each discipline.Similar situations are going on in other disciplines such CISP CSCI. These courses are very similar and do have the same C-ID descriptor.There should be some kind of review or evaluation with transparency to address these issues.It is recommended that (C&I) develop a policy statement for C-ID submission outside of the discipline.				
	Accreditation Expectation – V. Burley	New degrees and certificates must be reported to the AACJC annually. The AACJC is expecting colleges to monitor the program changes and keep records of substantive changes. For example, if 51% of courses are taken online for a particular degree, it requires submission of substantive changes. Before, these changes were submitted through financial Aid as part of the Gainful Employment requirements. If an online course is in the catalog, it is considered active				

			whether it is being offered in that modality or not. As far as GE courses, if faculty develop a distance learning HIST or BIOL General Education course, students could take 51% of the units earned for a degree through distance learning. The College must develop a monitoring system for the Instruction Office to use for these purposes.					
Inactivatio	n of courses – T. Long		The Curriculum Office will initiate the paper work needed for inactivating courses severely overdue (see attachment). Terri indicated that faculty who submitted their courses by the deadline who do not respond to EDC's recommendation for change cannot be offered until they have final approval and have been implemented. Courses that have not followed proper protocols for review and approval by the end of the academic year will not be offered. KIN 85 was pulled from the inactivation list and will continue to be an active course.
