	The Committee felt that of the dental alternatives proposed for DPPO plan, it would be worth exploring, with the various constituencies, the benefits of lowering the yearly maximum and adding orthodontia. This would result in approximately the same premiums. No changes to the DHMO plan were proposed.
