3. Revisions to AP 3720	The committee reviewed the first draft of changes to AP 3720. The committee discussed breaking out employees and students as two separate groups with distinct needs. The out-dated technical language like not forwarding email and not using high bandwidth applications like net radio or internet videos needs to be removed. The group agreed that the College's infrastructure has improved so much and that student's rely on these types of internet activities so listing them as 'banned' was no longer accurate. 4. Strategic Use of Campus Technology Investment	The committee discussed the large investment the campus has made in technology and if there are ways to use it more efficiently. The committee agreed that this would be a good topic for a Flex Day presentation.
