3. Updates	 3.1 AWE: 3.1.1 E. Hill-Enriquez regretfully announced that long time AWE reader Stan Nemeth passed away unexpectedly last week. 3.1.2 Facilitators are in the process of preparing norming papers and training packets for AWE new reader training on October 9, 2015. Seven new readers are scheduled to attend. 	

- 3.2 Learning Assistance:
 - 3.2.1 D. Rowley shared fliers for the Parachutes & Ladders Fall Follow-up on October 16, 2015. This Developmental Education Study Team interactive workshop will continue to examine best teaching practices presented last spring at the Fourteenth Annual Parachutes & Ladders Conference.
 - 3.2.2 D. Rowley also reported that a READ 100 student survey is being conducted by reading faculty to examine increased enrollment in READ 100 courses.

3.3 Counseling:

- 3.3.1 A. Lujan reported that his name has been submitted for consideration on a statewide Senate subcommittee for assessment and placement. This group is a subcommittee of an educational planning group and may possibly address common assessment.
- 3.3.2 A. Lujan shared that orientations are now offered twice per week throughout the year, not just prior to the start of each term. Counseling is revisiting the current orientation schedule to determine effectiveness and adjust frequency if needed. For new students, a recommendation is made for inperson orientation. For students who come from Citrus or other colleges, online orientation is acceptable.
- 3.3.3 T. Mauch reported that counseling held a faculty/staff/manager retreat last week. One of the issues discussed addressed challenges related to counseling vs. teaching time and student impact.
- 3.3.4 T. Mauch shared that the two new general counselors are in the evaluation process. A CalWorks counselor needs to be hired, but the Title V counselor, international counselor, and veterans counselor have been hired.
- 3.4. Continuing Ed./ESL:
 - 3.4.1 D. Santiago attended Region 8 SSSP Meeting at Rio

Hondo last Friday. Long Beach and Rio Hondo are chasing enrollment and students are aware of which colleges have hard or soft holds.
