Academic Senate • Report	<ul> <li>There are no current resolutions pertaining to SLOs/GEOs at the Academic Senate.</li> <li>The Academic Senate did send the Committee the following goals to be worked on:</li> <li>On September 18, the Academic Senate held a retreat to create its goals. At this retreat several academic and professional matters were identified. The Academic Senate Executive Board has directed me to refer these items to the appropriate committees. There are two items referred to the Outcomes Committee for discussion and recommendation:</li> <li>The need to create outcomes and an assessment plan for degree and certificate outcomes.</li> <li>Explore the ethnic awareness component (as required by Title 5) and information processing competency for inclusion in degrees. This last one may already exists as GEOs but should be communicated to the faculty</li> </ul>	Joan reported to the AS that the first of these goals was accomplished when the AS adopted the SLO Plan Addendum on October 1. We did not discuss this at the meeting.
