- Norming

 - Gail will continue to work on norming and the checklists in the future
- Review Area A GEO meeting
 - Disconnect exists between what was done and discussion due to the fact that the GEOs were assessed over a year ago
 - After the three GEO meetings this semester, it appear areas are not following the GEO rubric and process. Most are simply doing additional SLOs.
- Approved new purpose statement
