## MINUTES (Nov. 20, 2012)

- Announcements / updates
  - New Plan
    - Plan is to go to the Academic Senate on Dec 6. Some on the Exec. Board mentioned concerns over the 3-year rotation recommendation and suggested that a 4-year rotation might align better with our curriculum review. The Committee prefers the 3-year rotation for pedagogical reasons, but might be open to the 4-year rotation if it is preferable to the College.
  - GEOs Annel
    - Annel is evaluating courses that have SLO/GEO alignment and is making suggestions to units to use their SLO as a GEO if appropriate. She created a flowchart to walk areas through TracDat.
- AA Liberal Arts Degrees assessment
  - The OC is charged with assessing AA Liberal Arts degrees that are crossdepartmental in nature. The process could include the following:
    - Focus by dept course and survey students who have had a minimum number of units, using RIE Office to target appropriate students.
      - Perhaps faculty would have to assess just a few students in a course.
    - Focus on critical thinking or other themes that are broader in scope, perhaps use the AACU Value Rubrics
    - Look for capstone or culminating courses.
- 2013 Presidential Awards
  - Date for submission and review April 8, 2013
  - Announce awards in December and in May
  - Review rubric for evaluation and form for next meeting
- 4-year review of courses
  - Review courses in Spring that are up for 4-year review and forward comments to departments. Should we use the rubric from our old SLO plan? How do we determine if quality work has been accomplished? Perhaps evaluate lightly and send examples?
