MINUTES (Nov. 6, 2012)

- SLO Conversation recap
 - Focus was on teaching, not on TracDat, training, or other processes. OC wishes to continue this type of focus.
- Final Outcomes Plan and AP
 - "Per the Administrative Procedure on Program and Curriculum Development (AP 4020), if a course that is required for a degree or certificate has not completed an outcomes cycle within a period of five years, the Educational Design Committee or Curriculum and Instruction Council may propose inactivation."
 - Concern exists at the Senate between 3, 4, and 5-year aspects of the plan.
- Midterm Report The committee spent time reviewing and addressing our section of the Midterm Report that is being prepared by RIE. Our comments and evidence were forwarded to Barbara for inclusion in the larger document. The OC needs to continue to make the program-level outcomes work on the college more robust and help departments with this responsibility. However, the OC believes that our new plan will address a number of the qualitative concerns mentioned in our last accreditation visit.
- GEOs Annel
 - Annel will work with departments to determine if their completed SLO work can also count as their GEO efforts. She will forward information to appropriate department chairs, deans, and OC Coordinator.
- Department Chair training for Spring 2013
 - Jason plans to host a department chair training session to assist chairs with TracDat issues, program-level outcomes, and GEOs for Spring 2013. Additionally, Jason will recommend to IEC to decouple PIE from TracDat, so that TracDat can be streamlined for easier use by departments.
