- TracDat 5 Training Session
 - Outcomes Committee members reviewed and tested TracDat 5, including entering outcomes and means of assessment and mapping outcomes.
 - Annel, Emily, and Mark will present TracDat 5 to the Instruction managers on March 16.
 - TracDat 5 will be launched on April 1.

New Business

- Mapping Program Level and Institutional Level (B.McNeice-Stallard)
 - Committee members reviewed progress on program level outcomes (PLO) and institutional level outcomes (ILO).
 - o PLO assessment is ongoing with the following data reported on 1/21/2016:
 - Summary of Outcome Created: Completed 282 out of 300 (94%)
 - Summary of Summary of Data: Completed 265 out of 300 (88.33%)
 - Summary of Use of Results: Completed 259 out of 300 (86.33%)
 - o ILO mapping is still being counted, but the number of completed mapping documents appears to be low. Good success rates were found in divisions, which hosted facilitated division meetings dedicated to outcomes mapping. It was suggested the Outcomes Committee consider hosting a few sessions during Spring 2016 to (a) introduce TracDat 5 and (b) facilitate outcomes mapping.
