Assessment & Matriculation – Jim Ocampo	 The following minutes were approved and distributed to the Council: September 25, 2013 The following was reported from the most recent meeting: Review of AWE Rubric : inter-rater reliability review. Jim explained that placement is recommended by 2 readers. If there isn't agreement, it is read by a 3rd reader. There is an 82% inter-rater reliability from 2 readers. For the other 18%, the third reader will agree with one of the other 2 readers, making it 100% interrater reliability. There are no longer 4th and 5th readers. Reading Requirements Issue: Jim reported that Eric suggested having a task force to address the SP&S recommendation (directive).
