a.	Assessment & Matriculation – Jim Ocampo -Placement Distribution Data -No minutes available	 Jim reviewed the Placement Distribution Data with the Council. The following was shared: Changes to English Placement: Research is generating success rates on those who completed assessment under the new rubric as well as those who were placed by multiple measures. AWE Pilot will be presented upon the completion of the pending research. The data will be compiled monthly and is shared through the Assessment Committee whose members can carry the data back to their respective departments. 	 At a future meeting, Jim will provide an update on the following: AWE Pilot Satisfaction Survey Results Math Test Placement Appeal.



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		Barbara commended Counseling for working with students to address basic skills/reading issues early.	
		 Other information shared: A satisfaction survey from LERN, AmLa and English courses is being conducted. All students are surveyed, but the results are separated by students who were initially placed into the class. The Math Placement Test was submitted for approval to the Chancellor's Office in April, however the approval was denied. The denial was mainly based on "content validity." However, the narrative in the content review section was the same as was submitted in prior years (2001 and 2007). Jim Ocampo submitted an appeal to the Chancellor's Office with the Math Department's and the Committee's input.

The following was shared: A conflicting reference in "Hispanic" and "Latino" was pointed out –with the explanation that "Hispanic" references 	The Council recommended that the plan be sent to the Oct 20 th meeting for approval.

The following were suggested changes: move the paragraph below "Students who are admitted provisionally" above the inserted passage 	 The Council recommended the following: To approve the BP 5010 in concept. Develop a process to implement BP 5010 and included the process in AP 5010. Bring back the BP when the AP is ready to be reviewed by the Council.

		George presented a flow chart identifying the options after the receipt of expulsion information related to the offenses defined in 76038.	
b.	BP 5050 – Matriculation/SSSP - Jim AP 5050—Matriculation/SSSP – Jim	 BP 5050: Student Success and Support Program. The Council reviewed the revised BP and made the following corrections: Combing the second and fourth paragraph to read: The College President/CEO in consultation with the Academic Senate and the Chief Student Services Officer and the recommendations of the SSSP Advisory Committee shall establish procedures to assure implementation of SSSP services that comply with relevant law and regulations. Third paragraph include all services identified in Title 5 section 55520: Assessment, Orientation, Counseling and advising, Educational planning, Follow-Up services, Referral to support services and curricular offerings Move the exemption criteria back from the AP 5050 to the BP. ["A student is exempt (5) has enrolled at the college as a special admit student"] All references to the loss of priority enrollment should be moved to AP 5055. 	The Council unanimously approved BP 5050 with the recommended changes.
