C.	Basic Skills – Glenda Bro Minutes – September 25, 2014		The Council accepted October 8 <sup>th</sup> minutes.
3.0	CCSSE Presentation – Barbara McNiece-Stallard and Minerva Avila	Barbara McNeice-Stallard and Minerva Avila presented a review of the CCSSE results administered Spring 2014 to 1,372 students and 298 faculty. Major findings:  • For the first time, Mt. SAC exceeded the "Extra Large College Cohort" (ELCC) scores in all five benchmark areas.  • For the first time, Mt. SAC exceeded the ELCC on the Student-Faculty Interaction benchmark.  • There was continued growth in three out of five benchmark categories: Active and Collaborative Learning, Academic Challenge, Student-Faculty Interaction Recommendations presented by RIE:  • Increase the Student-Faculty Interaction	Minerva will share more specific details related to the Survey Results— especially on items where there is a wide discrepancy between faculty and students.  The Council will continue to review the Custom Survey results and consider recommending different items in order to further clarify findings related to Student-Faculty Interaction and Student Effort as well as other benchmark areas.
