SAC on September 30 <sup>th</sup> . Anabel Perez and Matt Munro presented on Mt. SAC's Summer Bridge Program. Other reports were given by representatives from other community colleges on Early Alert (Chaffey College) and Acceleration (Citrus, Chaffey, and Moreno Valley).

The committee members should read the report before the next meeting and come with ideas for resolutions that might be made to such groups such as SP&S and the Academic Senate. Anabel suggested that we contact the student government organization to alert them of these recommendations so that they too can have a voice. Glenda will investigate whether or not 3CSN and the State Academic Senate will be making a statement about these recommendations.
