2. Update on AQ 2	<p>Audrey shared that almost 4000 students have taken the AQ 2. Confidence about math, English, and reading placements has improved based on survey results from Mountie Fast Track sessions.</p> <p>Chuong shared a glitch on the AQ 2. If student submitted application for fall. If taking AQ for current summer term. Ask if major correct, then change major for summer term, but then</p>	

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	<p>show major for fall term. Students confused why major is not updating. This glitch has been fixed.</p> <p>Chuong shared another glitch. Students were showing that they finished the AQ 2, but SOATEST wasn't showing any records. We found the mistake.</p> <p>Patricia reported that assessment is confusing for Special Admit students. Most of them are multiple measures. We need to talk about this more in Phase 3. There has been an increase in applications for Special Admits. M Sampat mentioned that she would anticipate more dual enrollment as a result of outreach.</p>

New Summary Document Listing All Recommendations and Student Messages Received	David shared a couple of documents for committee members to review. One was a draft that summarizes on one document all the recommendations that SSSPAC has made to SP&S. The other was a draft that summarizes the assessment process for various groups of students.	
7. AMLA Update on NNES AQ	On September 11, 2019, a PowerPoint will be shown to talk about what needs to be done with regards to non-native English speakers. This will make sure everyone is on the same page about what changes need to happen and what needs to be worked on.	
8. Counseling Update on Guidance Efforts	Patricia shared that counselors will have training about guidance efforts. E Hill-Enriquez emphasized the need for counselors to feel comfortable helping students self-identify their primary language. If the primary language is not English, counselor refers student to the AWE. If the primary language is English, student receives default English placement. Note: The AWE does not necessarily place into AMLA. The AWE can place from ESL (noncredit) into AMLA or into English 1A and English 1A/80 via MM. All AWE placement tests receive MM manually.
