**Note: An overall grade point average of 2.5 with no grade less than a "C" for each course; Only "one" D/F grade repeat of any of the three prerequisites Anatomy, Physiology, and Microbiology is allowed. Ws or EWs do not count toward the repeat policy.

1. Physical Well Being Physical Well Being Requirement: Complete a least one of the physical education activity courses with the following prefixes: DNCE, KINA, KINF, KINI, KINL, KINS, KINX with a grade of "C" or better or "P" (Pass)
 2. Reading Competency: This requirement is met by completing one of the following with a grade of "C" or better.
 - READ 90 Reading College Texts or
 - AMLA 33R American Language Advance Reading or
 - Obtaining placement into READ 100 on the Reading placement exam.
 3. Mathematics Competency: This requirement is met by completing one of the following with a grade of "C" or better:
 - *Math 71 Intermediate Algebra or*
 - *Math 71B Intermediate Algebra-Second half or*
 - *Math 71X Practical Intermediate Algebra or*
 - Completing a more advanced college-level mathematics course or
 - Obtaining a satisfactory score on the Intermediate Algebra Competency Examination
- *Beginning Fall 2022, Math 71, 71B, and Math 71X will no longer be offered*
