DL Course Amendment Review	Committee reviewed PHIL 9 submitted by Timothy Quandt and CHLD 10 submitted by Karen Curran. Clarification was requested on two items, and suggestions were made for minor revisions.	Courses, PHIL 9 and CHLD 10, were approved for submission to the Educational Design Committee once the revisions have been made.
Curriculum Update	A new four-year review cycle has begun for the review of all courses. Beginning Fall 2006, courses which are not in compliance may not be offered. All courses submitted for Distance Learning approval must have a current effective date. Gina Tjaden has made a list of all DL courses and the effective date that appears in ICCIS.
