ITEM	DISCUSSION	OUTCOME
1. CCCAssess Implementation Team	<p>1.1 J. Ocampo shared an email from CCC Assess that CAI implementation has been postponed. Discussion followed on possible factors that may have contributed to the delay: not enough documentation about how the system will work, especially placement model, questions about validity of branching, more items are needed in the test bank, fairness/bias review not started, criterion and consequential related evidence unavailable, unclear how minimum student measures will be selected, and there are no details about how placement model will work.</p> <p>1.2 ImplementationTeam members discussed whether or not to continue moving forward reviewing competencies even though Common Assessment implementation dates have been postponed. A recommendation was made to continue mapping competencies and creating placement formulas; however, E. Hill-Enriquez added that competencies might change so mapping would be wasting time.</p>	1.1 No communication has been provided as to how long Common Assessment will be postponed.

	<p>E. Hill-Enriquez will attend CAI update in San Luis Obispo next week. J. Ocampo, T. Mauch, L. DeLeon, Madelyn Arballo, and E. Lara will attend state SSSP conference in Sacramento September 27<sup>th</sup>-29<sup>th</sup>. Compass tests will run-out during Spring 2017. This test is currently used at Mt. SAC for ESL reading. There may be a possibility that the Chancellor's Office may contact ACT about extending Compass.</p> <p>1.3 There was a short discussion regarding Mt. SAC's Multiple Measure Task Force to examine GPA alone as a MM for placement; however, the Chancellor's Office sent a memo stating that GPA alone is not a MM. Course lists must be taken into consideration as well as GPA. A suggestion was made to use Hope Theory MM questions to push out immediate and timely suggestions for student support (early alerts to counselors and recommendations for counseling and STDY courses).</p>	<p>1.3 At the next SSSPAC meeting, further discussion will take place on how students answer Mt. SAC's Hope Theory questions in relation to their success in classes.</p>
