Advanced Placement (AP) exams with scores of 3, 4, or 5 can be used to satisfy general education requirements.

How may the IB satisfy general education (GE) requirements?

International Baccalaureate (IB) Higher Level (HL) exams with scores of 5, 6, or 7 can be used to satisfy general education requirements.

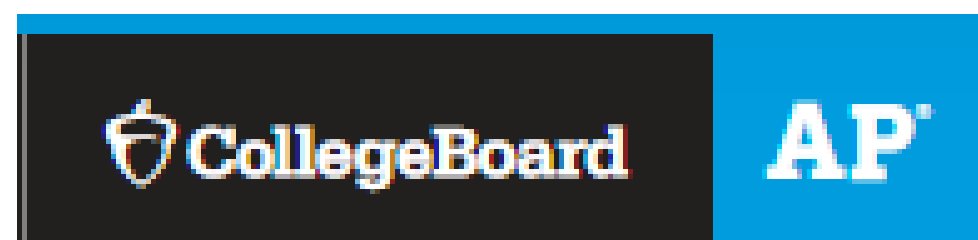
