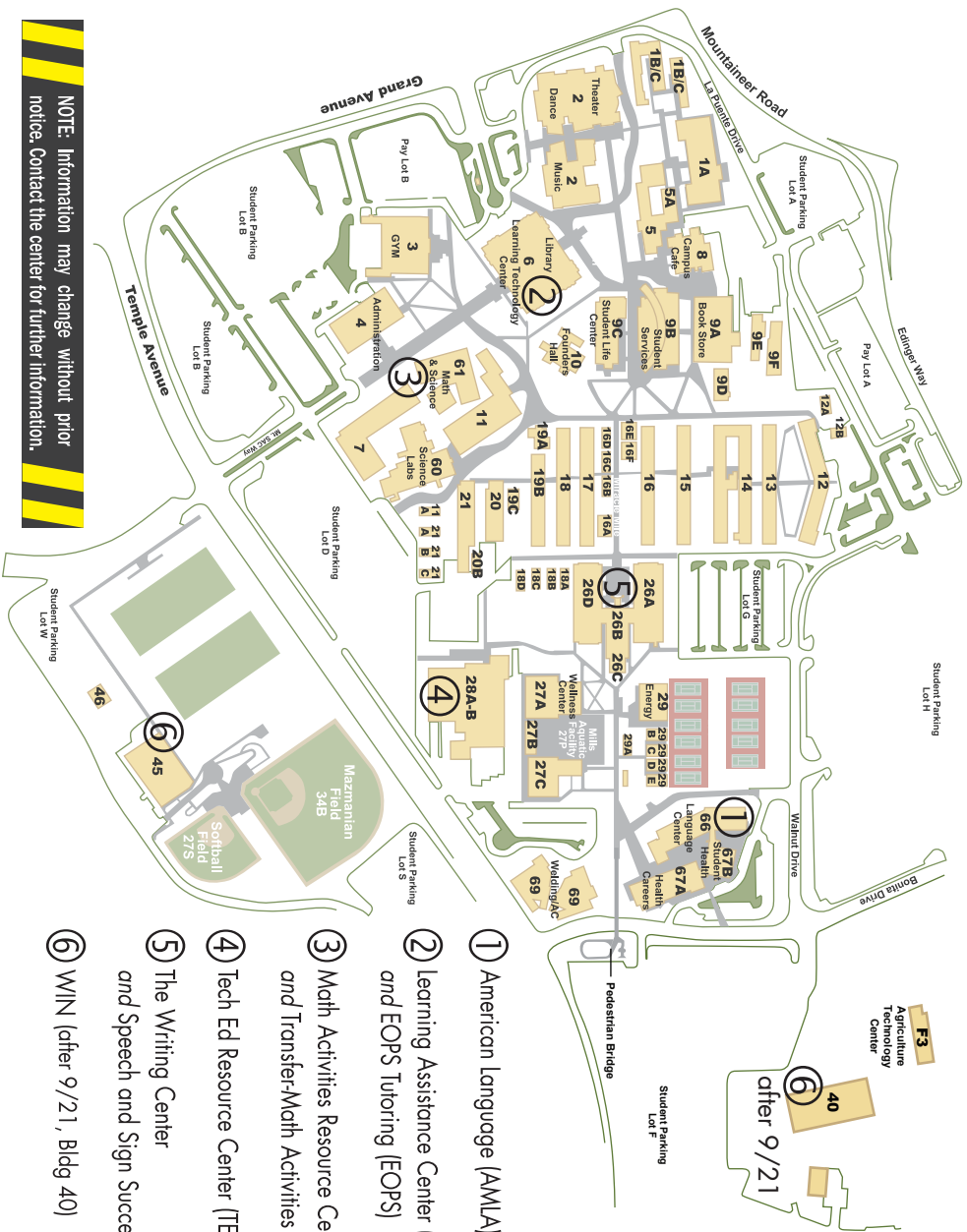

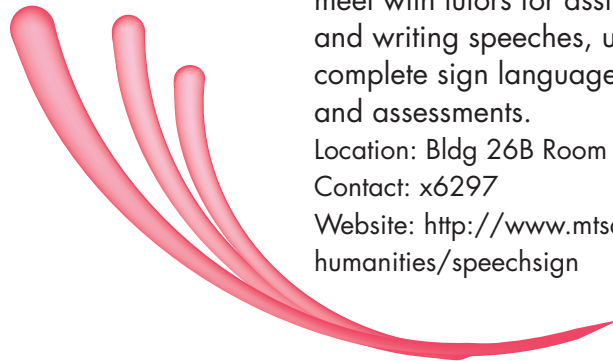
## **Math Activities Resource Center**

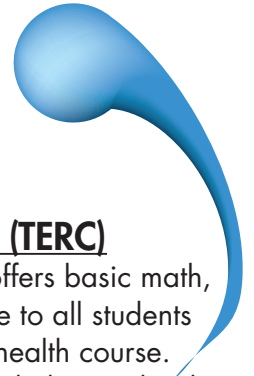
## **Learning Assistance Center (LAC) Tutorial Services**
