**Additional Requirements or Notes:**

With instructor's recommendation and a grade of 80% (B) or better in all semesters of the secondary course(s), students may request articulation credit. The articulation exam will be in three parts. Part 1 is multiple choice/true-false, students scoring 70% or higher on part 1 will continue on to part 2 a written response. Students who earn a combined score of 70% on parts 1 and 2 will qualify for part 3, the practical exam. The practical exam will require students to demonstrate skills in timed taping of a joint (ankle), first aid, and three special tests Student must earn a cumulative score of 70% or higher to earn Mt. SAC credit. The written articulation exams will be completed in Mt. SACs Canvas Learning System. The practical demonstration exam will be conducted at Mt. SAC or through Zoom.
