5. Safety/Emergency Services Update – M. Cruse	Melonee provided an update to the Committee.	Melonee reported on: (1) a follow up to an Employee Safety Suggestion/Report of Hazard. The suggestion was for additional location signage in parking lots. After viewing parking lot signs it was determined that new, larger location signs are needed. This is a safety issue and important for dispatch, DSPS and local responders. (2) The need to develop an Emergency Operation Plan task force. The task force will review the current emergency operations plan and help develop missing plan elements. (3) The Injury Illness Prevention Program is being updated and will be discussed in upcoming meetings.
