Liaison Proposal – Jeff	<ul> <li>The following was discussed:</li> <li>There was a concern expressed to make the liaison assignments more known to the faculty.</li> <li>It was suggested to strike the list of departments, especially due to multiple disciplines, and focus more directly on the specifics of the liaison proposal.</li> </ul>	The Council recommended that Jeff consult with Angel Lujan and bring back as an action item at the next meeting on Dec 1 <sup>st</sup> .



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		<ul> <li>The Committee agreed to leave the departments as listed but show the disciplines.</li> <li>Jeff will seek clarity with Angel on the wording of the recommendations, especially to clarify the scope involving all "22" general counseling department faculty.</li> <li>Many committee members questioned why this proposal needs to go through the governance process. Dan explained that passing this proposal would express the ideal goal of attempting to provide a counselor liaison to instructional departments, as the need and interest provides. Also, the thought is to gather support from the faculty as to whether they want this or not.</li> </ul>
