Old Business	<ul> <li>Rondell emailed Denise Lindholm and Carol Nelson to make arrangements for breakfast (7:15am on 8/23) for College Champions award winners. She also contacted fiscal services to take care of transferring money into winners' accounts and notifying board members. Also, Rondell will find out if the VOICES Committee members need to RSVP for the breakfast.</li> <li>VOICES needs about \$3,000.00 per year for the College Champions award. A short discussion of "Discount Days" followed. Originally this was going to be used as a VOICES fundraiser; however, the foundation may turn out to be a better avenue for fund-raising.</li> <li>The "Retiree Archive" needs to be compiled and posted on website. It should start with last year's retirees. The retiree list is maintained by the President's Office.</li> <li>Rondell summarized the history of the College Champions award: Dr. Scroggin's vision was to have a group of people gather awards and recognitions from across campus. It took a full year to coordinate and start VOICES. He also wanted to give awards, so he started with the Outcomes award (Outstanding Curriculum, Outstanding Basic Skills, and Personal Innovation) for faculty.
