



UNDERSTANDING THE MT. SAC CATALOG

WHY IS THE COLLEGE CATALOG IMPORTANT?

- Contains rules, regulations, and policies.
- Has all academic programs requirements for certificates, degrees, and transfer general education patterns.
- Lists every class that is offered, including the number of units, a description, any prerequisites or advisories, whether the class is degree applicable or transferrable



WHAT DOES "CATALOG YEAR" MEAN?

- The semester/year you begin at Mt. SAC is your catalog year or any future catalog as long as continuous attendance is maintained.

WHY ARE "CATALOG RIGHTS" IMPORTANT?

- Catalog rights permit students to keep the initial catalog program & policies when enrollment began at Mt. SAC or select a future catalog if a program changes.



HOW DO I KEEP CATALOG RIGHTS?

- Maintain continuous attendance: Enrollment and attendance in a class (past the census date) in one of the immediate prior two semesters (intersession attendance does not apply towards catalog rights)
- Attend another regionally accredited post-secondary institution and maintain "continuous attendance" up to two-years
