

CALIFORNIA CHILD DEVELOPMENT PERMIT

- Child Development Permits are issued through the [California Commission on Teacher Credentialing \(CCTC\)](#).
- Required for employment as a child development teacher, supervisor or director within a state-funded, Title 5, or federally funded child development program
- Holding a permit will make you more marketable, typically earning higher salaries & better benefits
- Permits are valid for 5 years from the date they are issued; higher-level permits can be renewed.
