- 1. Physical Well Being Physical Well Being Requirement: Complete a least one of the physical education activity courses with the following prefixes: DNCE, KINA, KINF, KINI, KINL, KINS, KINX with a grade of "C" or better or "P" (Pass)
- 2. Reading Competency: This requirement is met by completing one of the following with a grade of "C" or better.
  - READ 90 Reading College Texts or
  - o AMLA 33R American Language Advance Reading or
  - Obtaining placement into READ 100 on the Reading placement exam.
- 3. Mathematics Competency: This requirement is met by completing one of the following with a grade of "C" or better:
  - Math 71 Intermediate Algebra or
  - o Math 71B Intermediate Algebra-Second half or
  - Math 71X Practical Intermediate Algebra or
  - Completing a more advanced college-level mathematics course or
  - Obtaining a satisfactory score on the Intermediate Algebra Competency Examination
- Beginning Fall 2022, Math 71, 71B, and Math 71X will no longer be offered
