One more thing! When the subject is singular or an infinitive verb, we use **gusta**. When the subject is plural, we must use **gustan**.

Me gusta estudiar. (singular subject)

Me gustan las computadoras. (plural subject)

Le gust**a la escuela**. (singular subject)

Te gustan los libros. (plural subject)

When we state the negative, we use "no" before the IOP:

No me gusta estudiar.

No te gusta la pizza.

No les gustan las clases de biología.


