Applications for FALL Semester:	Due by 3 p.m. on the <u>last</u> Monday of June
Applications for WINTER Intersession:	Due by 3 p.m. on the <u>last</u> Monday of October
Applications for SPRING Semester:	Due by 3 p.m. on the <u>first</u> Monday of January
Applications for SUMMER Intersession:	Due by 3 p.m. on the last Monday of April
